Cooperation project with African schools

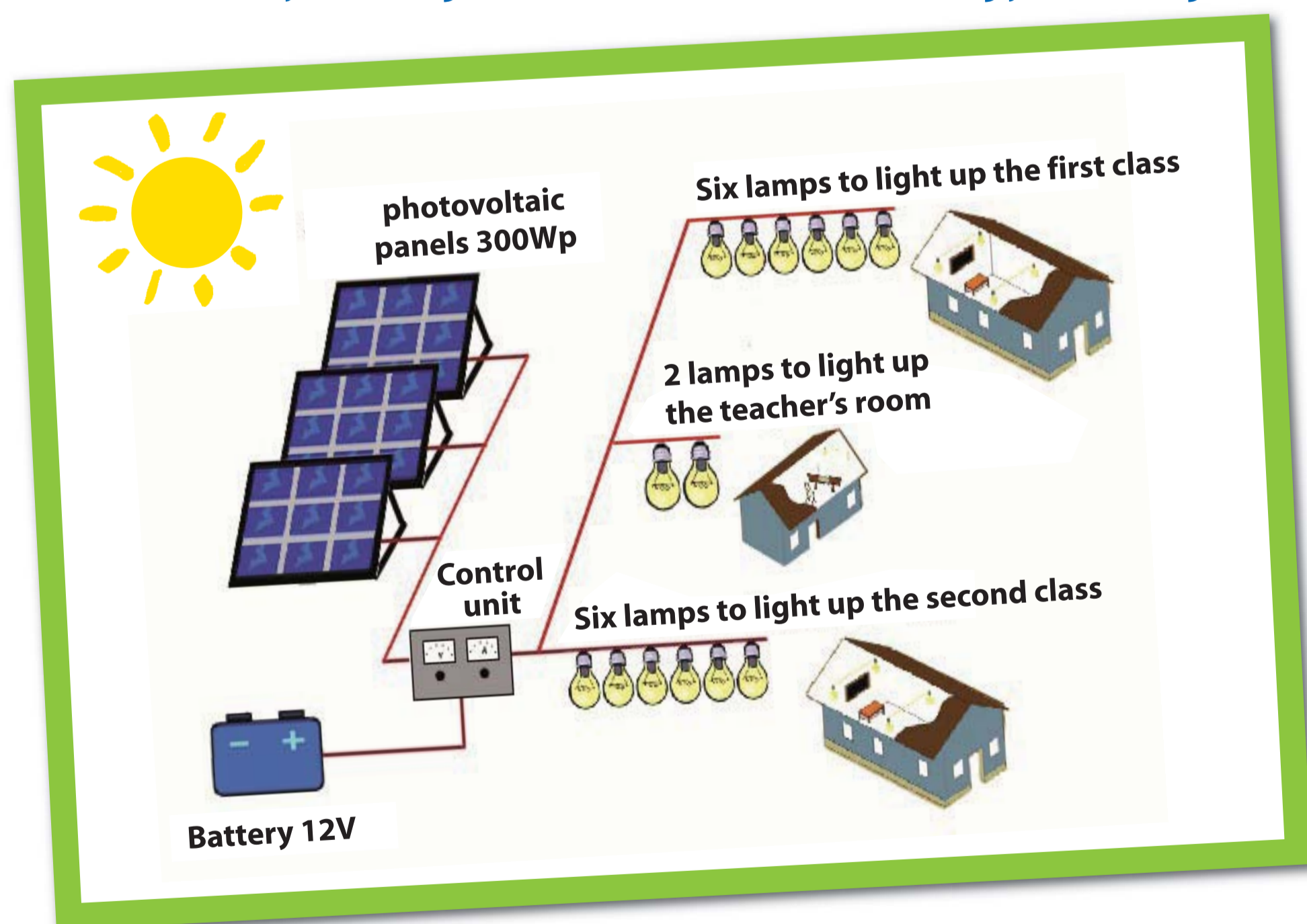


The SUSTAIN campaign aims to create partnerships between African and Italian schools interested in exchanging teaching experiences and training, and establish new relationships between students of different regions of the world.

Students of an Italian school, by donating a few euros, can purchase a solar kit by which illuminate an African school of a rural village with no electricity. Schools become the protagonist of a concrete action in support of the Millennium Goals for tackling poverty, promoting primary education and environmental sustainability, thanks to the dissemination of new sustainable technologies.

A solar kit to light up a school

The kit consists of photovoltaic panels (total power 300 Wp), 1 battery (12V - 200 Ah), 1 battery charge controller, 15 energy-saving lamps, cables and switches.



The photovoltaic system is able to light up two classrooms and the teacher's home. It is simple to install and can be handled easily by the teacher. Students from Italian schools could donate a kit, which costs about 1200 €, just donating 1 € each.
